

Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards--Birth to Kindergarten

Revision Projected Timeline

Purpose: The purpose of revising the current Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards is to ensure that standards are rich, interactive, and lead to better preparation for children based on current research to support high quality standards.

■ Summer 2017

- DOE Office of Early Learning hosts rule development workshops based on panel of experts' work.
- Based on rule development workshops, revisions are finalized and publicly noticed.
- Coordinated training plan and related resources are developed.

■ Fall 2017

- *Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards--Birth to Kindergarten (2017)* and *Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards--4 Years Old to Kindergarten (2017)* are submitted to State Board of Education for approval.
- Rules are published in the Florida Administrative Register.

■ Spring/Summer 2018

- *Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards--Birth to Kindergarten (2017)* and *Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards--4 Years Old to Kindergarten (2017)* training and related resources are available statewide.

■ Fall 2018

- *Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards--Birth to Kindergarten (2017)* and *Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards--4 Years Old to Kindergarten (2017)* are implemented in School Readiness and VPK programs.
