1. The <i>Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards: Birth to Kindergarten</i> are used to plan instruction.		
2. The learning environment is thoughtfully planned and includes opportunities for children to engage in critical and creative thinking.		
3. Developmentally and culturally appropriate materials provide for a range of abilities and are in good condition, organized and changed often.		
4. Teachers are engaged with children during active, hands-on learning experiences that are initiated both by the teacher and the child.		
5. Instruction is planned and provided in a variety of formats (e.g., whole group, small group, learning centers, during daily routines and transitions).		
6. One-on-one interactions are planned each day to meet each child’s specific learning needs.		
7. Content is integrated with concepts and skills throughout the day (e.g., a theme is carried through whole group, small groups, learning centers inside and outside).		
8. Each child’s progress is monitored through formal and informal assessment and observation.
