Maintegrated Classroom Curriculum An integrated classroom curriculum is a child-centered learning environment with developmentally appropriate learning experiences that are planed and implemented throughout the day.	Integrated Classroom Curriculum An integrated <i>classroom</i> <i>curriculum</i> focuses on creating a child-centered learning environment providing developmentally appropriate learning experiences that are planned and implemented throughout the day. 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4.	Quality Learning Environment A positive climate helps preschoolers feel secure and encourages learning.	Guided Discussion: What are ways your learning environment provides opportunities for children to engage in critical and creative thinking?
5.	Child-centered Classroom An effective instructor will use a child's personal and cultural knowledge to build on each child's strengths and skills.	Guided Discussion: Think about your classroom. Do your materials and resources meet the needs of your children?

"Children should be engaged in many hands-on experiences throughout the day." What is meant by hands-on learning experiences?

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8.	Balanced Instruction Throughout the course of the day, the curriculum should include instruction in varying formats, such as large group, small group, and learning centers.	Guided Discussion: What does your daily schedule look like? How do you provide a balance of instruction?
9. P. P. P. P. P. P. P. P. P. P	One-on-One Interactions Through one-on-one interactions with children, teachers are able to build trusting relationships, scaffold learning and provide feedback and support.	Guided Discussion: How do you plan to meet with each child every day?
10.	Monitoring Children's Progress It is important to ensure that all children are on a continuous path of improvement and on target in meeting expected growth and development outcomes.	Guided Discussion: What formal and informal assessments are being used in the preschool classrooms? How are educators using this information?
11.	Learning Throughout the Day Learning goals are integrated in daily activities.	Guided Discussion: In what way are learning concepts and skills practiced throughout the learning day.
12.	Daily Routines Daily routines are excellent opportunities for teachers to practice and reinforce concepts and skills.	Activity: List the daily routines throughout the day and add a learning goal that could be addressed during the daily routine.

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13.	Transitions Effective teachers will use the opportunity to transition from one activity to the next by practicing and reinforcing a variety of skills.	Activity: List the transitions that happen throughout the day and add a learning goal that could be addressed at this time.
14.	Video: Daily Routines and Transitions	Video Activity: Look at your list of routines and transitions, then add a few ideas as you watch the video.
15.	One Activity Builds on Another When teachers integrate the curriculum across multiple domains it will lead to better outcomes for children.	Guided Discussion: How does this example demonstrates "one activity builds on another."
16.	Video: One Activity Builds on Another	Video Activity: List the domains as they are addressed in the lesson.
17.	Content Integration Integrating concepts and skills within planned activities throughout the day will support children's learning success in all areas of growth and development.	Guided Discussion: Why is it important to integrate content throughout the day?
